What is Dry Eye?

Dry eye occurs when the eye doesn't produce enough tears, or the tears are not of the correct consistency and evaporate too quickly

Common symptoms:

- Frequent tearing
- Blurry vision
- Redness
- Irritated/scratchy eyes
- Mucus in & around eyes
- Light sensitivity

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Additional At Home Remedies and Instructions for Use

Only use those circled & recommended by your Eye Doctor

Warm Compress

- 1. Purchase a Gel Beaded Eye Mask
- 2. Heat the mask for 10-15 seconds in a microwave or until it's comfortable
- 3. Place over closed eyes for 10 minutes
- 4. Repeat steps 1-3 as needed or as directed

Night Ointment: Optase Night Hylo (Preservative Free)

- Squeeze a small amount of ointment into the lower eyelid pocket before bed, then blink to spread it.
- Will cause blurry vision.

Lid Scrubs

- Close your eyes and gently scrub the base of your upper and lower lashes using the wipe in a side-toside motion.
- Rinse eyes and pat dry with a clean towel.
- Repeat 2-3x/week at night.

Optase Cleaning Gel (Preservative Free)

- Gently massage the gel onto your closed eyelids and the base of your eyelashes in a circular motion.
- Rinse eyes and pat dry with a clean towel.
- Repeat 2-3x/week usually in the shower.

Hypochlorous Acid Spray: Avenova

- Close your eyes.
- Hold the spray bottle about 8-10 inches from your face.
- Spray directly onto your closed eyelids, ensuring an even mist covers the entire eyelid area.
- Let the spray air-dry on your eyelids; no rinsing is necessary.
- Use nightly.
- Wear UV protective sunglasses
- Use a humidifier
- Clean your eye area regularly
- Stay hydrated Drink water!
